I will be coming to Seoul this coming December 2011 and I would like to apply for any English teaching positions that are available in the Gangnam area working with children or adults.

I am currently working full time as a nursery teacher for three year olds of all nationalities; Spanish, Italian, Korean, Chinese and Portuguese. I also have experience working with adults during private classes after my nursery job.

Teaching young children is hard work and demanding and requires much patience, but I find the position extremely rewarding and very important in a child's development and important for their future, and I enjoy making a difference to their lives from such a young age. Working with adults can also be very demanding, but with adults it becomes more about developing existing skills and knowledge and catering for different requirements and levels depending on their personal needs. Working with adults brings different dynamics to a class which is a really important element for learning.

One job that I particularly liked was in the summer of last year when I went to China for one month as a volunteer to teach English to groups of employees from a charity organisation called the Amity Foundation. I really enjoyed teaching in a country in which their mother tongue was not based on a Romance language system (Latin based languages of Western Europe) as I had to focus on different aspects of language teaching skills such as extra work in pronunciation and sentence word structure which is dissimilar to Asian languages.

Some points that I would to highlight for you are the following:

- I am a passionate and professional teacher
